What is a knowledge node?

- An organization or network of organizations that can take a leading role for capacity development for sustainable sanitation in a country or region.
- Identification of organizations is on-going
 1. Independent scoping study ←
 2. Validation of results from scoping study in workshop with stakeholders
 3. Call for proposal to host the node
 4. Evaluation of node hosting proposals
 5. Establishment of node
