


#### What is a knowledge node?

- An organization or network of organizations that can take a leading role for capacity development for sustainable sanitation in a country or region.
- Identification of organizations is on-going
  - Independent scoping study
  - 2. Validation of results from scoping study in workshop with stakeholders
  - 3. Call for proposal to host the node
  - 4. Evaluation of node hosting proposals
  - 5. Establishment of node
