#### Situation of the Water and Sanitation infrastructure (1991 – 2001)





- Situation of the Water and Sanitation infrastructure (urban)
- 4 ministries covering the reasonability of the water management
- and 3 agencies
- Water utility boards in the urban areas and districts centres (Apă-Canal)





- Kolkhoz & Sovhoz ran systems (before 1991)
- Municipalities without any capacity to run the systems



- no tariffs, no responsibilities, no ownership, no service
- 35 % of the rural population have centralized drinking water supply
- 5 % of the rural population with efficient sewer and wastewater treatment system
- Wide gap between urban and rural zones!



### SDC objectives and approaches in rural areas

#### **Objectives**

- increase the access to drinking water and sanitation (MDG Nr. 7)
- strengthen the water and sanitation management in the rural zones
- introduce the notions of "self-financing" and "sustainability"

#### **Approach**

- bottom-up with direct involvement of the concerned population
- increase ownership by contributions of all stakeholders
- increase participation by creation of a Water Consumers Association (WCA) directly from the beginning
- spread transparency by including also district authorities into the implementation

## Implementation of a system

#### Before the construction

- active communication with municipality and/or group of initiative
- creation of a WCA with statutes, registration, bank account, steering committee
- contract of cooperation with all set contributions

#### **During construction**

- every household becomes a member of the WCA with its contribution:
  - financial: € 35 to create the treasury
  - manual: 6 working days to assure the layout out of protection zones

50 m trench digging on the main network

building of the individual connection chamber

#### After construction

- exploitation concession given by municipality
- yearly assembly to elect the steering committee
- billing system to assure the self financing of the system
- responsibilities clearly set to assure the system's maintenance


